

Eligibility for Starr Vaughn Equestrian Year-end High Point Awards H/J

The following classes count for the eight year-end high point awards:

Pleasure:

Any class with the Pleasure name attached to it requiring the three gaits, walk, trot, and canter. To count for the Pleasure division, classes may not be part of any other division, i.e, Short or Long Stirrup. Examples of classes that count; Jr or Sr Pleasure, Color or Non-Color Pleasure, Horse or Pony Pleasure.

Short Stirrup:

Any class with the Short Stirrup name attached to it; Pleasure, Hunter Under Saddle, Hunters, Equitation, Eq on the Flat.

Long Stirrup:

Any class with the Long Stirrup name attached to it; Pleasure, Hunter Under Saddle, Hunters, Equitation, Eq on the Flat.

Child/Adult Hunters:

Any class held with the Children's Hunter or A/A Hunter name attached and held at 2'9"-3'. Can be Hunters, Handy Hunters, or Child/AA Hunters Under Saddle.

Jr/Am Equitation:

Any equitation class for junior riders (17/under) or amateur riders (18/over) that if held over fences is conducted at 2'9"-3' and if held on the flat judges all three gaits, the walk, trot and canter. Classes may not be part of any other division.

Low Adult Hunters:

Any class held over fences at 2'6" called Low Adult or Low Adult Handy Hunters, and on the flat called Low Adult Hunters Under Saddle and shown at the walk, trot, and canter.

Low Children's Hunters:

Any class held over fences at 2'6" called Low Children's or Low Children's Handy Hunters, and on the flat called Low Children's Hunters Under Saddle and shown at the walk, trot, and canter.

Jumpers:

Any jumper class held at 2'9" or above (combined 2'6"-2'9" not to count) and open to all riders.
